

Resolution Number 2007-12
RESOLUTION to Adopt Millage Ballot Language

WHEREAS, the Electors of Burt Township have not voted the allocated millage for general operating funds since 1984; and

WHEREAS, the allocated millage for Burt Township, after required rollbacks, is now at 0.6369 mills; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Burt Township wishes to increase the General Operating Millage levy to 1 mill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Burt Township, Alger County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the ~~August 8~~ November 6, 2007, election ballot:

Shall the voted allocated township millage rate of 1 mills, reduced to 0.6369 mills by the required millage rollbacks, be increased by 0.3631 mills (\$0.3631 per \$1,000 of taxable value) to recover that reduction and be levied by Burt Township, in the five (5) years, 2007 through 2012 inclusive, for general operating purposes, raising an estimated \$32,000.00 in the first year the millage is levied.
