

Resolution Number 2011-05 - CORRECTED
RESOLUTION to Adopt Millage Ballot Language

WHEREAS, the increase in the tax limitation for providing general operation, improvement and maintenance of cemetery, airport,, streets, roads, sidewalks, street lighting, recreation and grass cutting expired in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Burt Township wishes to renew the General Operating Millage levy of 3 mill for Township Improvement and to add “construction” to the language;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Burt Township, Alger County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 2, 2011 election ballot:

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Burt Township be increased by 3 mills (\$3.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for the period of 2011 through 2013 inclusive for providing general operation, construction, improvement and maintenance of cemetery, airport, streets, roads, sidewalks, street lighting, recreation and grass cutting; and shall the township levy such millage for said purpose, thereby, raising in the first year an estimated \$132,000.00?
