

Resolution Number 2012-03  
**RESOLUTION to Adopt Millage Ballot Language**

WHEREAS, the Electors of Burt Township have not voted the allocated millage for general operating funds since 1984; and

WHEREAS, the allocated millage for Burt Township, after required rollbacks, is now at 0.5821 mills; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Burt Township wishes to increase the General Operating Millage levy to 1 mill;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Burt Township, Alger County, approves the following millage ballot question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August 7, 2012, election ballot:

Shall the voted allocated township millage rate of 1 mills, reduced to 0.5821 mills by the required millage rollbacks, be increased by 0.4179 mills (\$0.4179 per \$1,000 of taxable value) to recover that reduction and be levied by Burt Township, in the five (5) years, 2012 through 2016 inclusive, for general operating purposes, raising an estimated \$44,835 in the first year the millage is levied.
