<u>**Campground Wi Fi proposal:**</u> Motion by Shafer, second by Lundquist, to accept the quote from Hiawatha Telephone Company to replace the two antenna/repeaters in the park to improve the Wifi service at a cost of \$2,108.33. 5 ayes
