Assessor Request – Resolution Property Transfer affidavit: Resolution 2019-02-04. <u>Motion by McShane</u>, second by Lundquist, to adopt resolution 2019-02-04, waiving the right of the township to charge a fee for the late filing of Property transfer affidavit. 4 ayes.

Salary Resolutions – Elected officials: Motion by McShane, second by Dongvillo, to adopt resolution 2019-02-01, increasing the supervisor salary to \$27,500.00 annually. 4 ayes.
