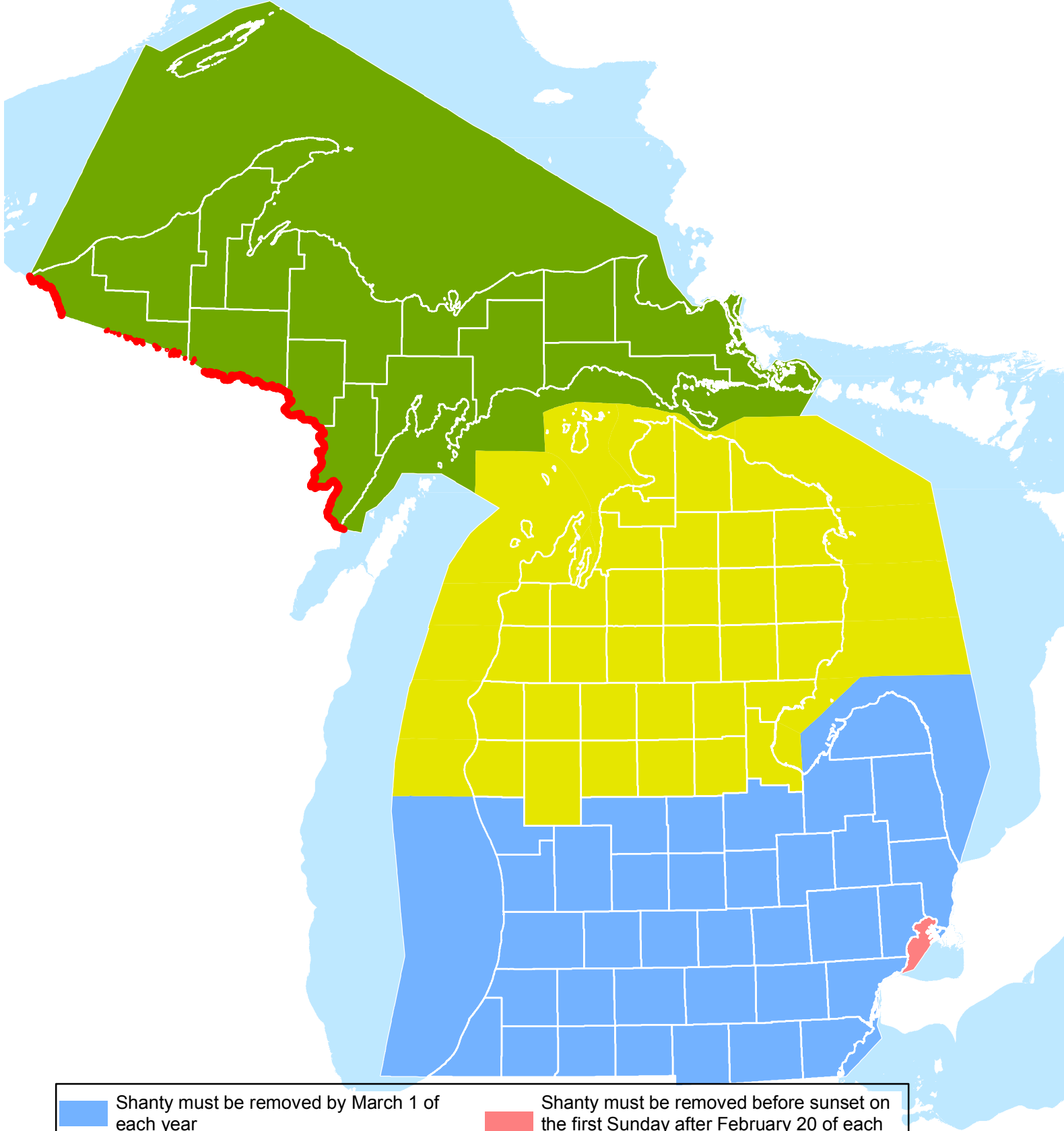


Michigan Ice Fishing Shanty Removal Date Information



- Shanty must be removed by March 1 of each year
- Shanty must be removed by March 15 of each year
- Shanty must be removed by March 31 of each year

- Shanty must be removed before sunset on the first Sunday after February 20 of each year (Lake St. Clair)
- Shanty must be removed by March 15 of each year (Michigan/Wisconsin Boundary Waters)

In all areas, a shanty must be removed if ice conditions become unsafe, regardless of the date. After the above dates, a shanty must be removed at the end of each day's fishing activity. Map created by the Institute for Fisheries Research. Last updated: 3/6/2019.
