Zoning Ordinance/Planning Commission: Planning commission is currently reviewing the county ORV ordinance and the township zoning ordinance.

New Business:

Grand Marais Housing PILT: Motion by Wieting, second by Leavenworth, to renew the agreement with the Grand Marais Citizens Housing Authority that authorizes a payment in lieu of taxes to be set at 6% of the unsubsidized tenant rental income for the next six years. 5 ayes.

Golf Cart Ordinance: Current county ORV ordinance considers golf carts under the same rules as ORV's. This needs to be publicized to the community as this puts extra restrictions on those operating golf carts in the township. The board has the authority to adopt a township ordinance that would segregate the golf carts from the ORV's and would specify the safety regulations that pertain to them. Board will continue to review and discuss.

<u>2nd Quarter budget review</u>: Copies of the budget through the second quarter of our fiscal year were distributed to the board for review. Special meeting to be scheduled to discuss and approve amendments needed.

<u>Jordan Donation</u>: The Township received a generous donation and we need to determine the best way of using these funds to honor the donor and help the township.
