*Interlibrary loan is working well again. There may be some "19" restrictions in place in Munising and other library's, but they are not affecting us here. I mask it and every patron that's come in here since I have returned has worn a mask. I anticipated a few problems with the mask requirement but none ever materialized-to the good!

Burt Township Department Reports

*The library "floor" is back in biz now. Things were a bit confused since I was reorganizing when 19 hit, then I had the hip bunga bunga hit me, so the place was in a bit of disarray, but it is back fairly orderly now.

*electronic equipment working well although I do have an occasional prob with this computer, but I'll see Lisa about that this winter. It's not any big deal anyway...

*Friends of the Library account (Peoples) is at 735.86 (those subscriptions cost money!) but I have a nice deposit to make soon. Date is September 30, 2020 for current statement.

*Looking forward to starting up with the "Library Annex", but it's a little too early for me to start pushing things around. I would, however, like to proceed with some work estimates for the room-cost of paint job, new carpet and wire in some new track lighting-all in due time. For now, estimates will do nicely. And they don't cost money!

Woodland Park & Marina

Closed for the season!

Public Works

- Fall leaf pick up at Rose Hill Cemetery, emergency service building, township offices, Bayshore park, Bayshore playground area, greenspace, smith property, medical center, war memorial, water tank, pump station, park on the point and right of ways by offices.
- Marina bathhouse and fish cleaning station winterized. Building plumbing blown out and then RV anti-freeze is pumped through plumbing to prevent things from freezing and breaking. Most of the water lines are hidden in the ceilings and block walls.
- Marina dock side water hook ups and pump out winterized and blown out.
- Rose Hill Cemetery water system blown out and winterized for season. The cemetery closes for the year on November 15th.
- Maintenance and pumping out water from the sumps on the fuel system regularly. Due to the new marina bathroom the fuel pump location is now one of the lowest points in the area which causes water to accumulate around the pumps frequently.
- Maintenance and garbage collection at the rifle range periodically as needed.
- Prepping seasonal equipment for storage and snow removal. Power washing mower decks and greasing before storage. Snow removal equipment checked and installed.
- Power washing and deep cleaning entry mats for the community center.
- Wiping down with disinfectant on frequently touched surfaces in the community center.
- Recycling returns to the recreation pole barn on November 18th from 9am to 12pm.
- New road way sign built in shop and installed for Mahoney lake road on h-58.
- Built four plexiglass barriers to protect election workers for the November 3rd election at the community center.
- Organizing and ordering Christmas decorations for this season. We will start to put up lights asap while we have decent weather.
- Trimmed a few trees in woodland park for the park manager that were hitting large RVs on the main roads. Also replaced three valves on RV water hook ups for the park manager.

Burt Township Department Reports

- Removed large amounts of junk and old furniture from the youth center that now will be extra space for the library.

Water Department

- Fire hydrant flushing completed. Hydrants are run to check for proper operation and pumped out for winter to prevent freezing and damage.
- Fire hydrant on Canal street was rebuilt with new gaskets and O-rings to improve its operation. Periodically fire hydrants need to be rebuilt and greased to maintain proper operation.
- Mainline valve turning on the water system. Water main valves are exercised to extend their service life and increases the operational reliability. Regular operation of valves can remove debris from the valve seat so full valve operation is achieved.
- Completed with the state of Michigan's stamp of approval (EGLE) the 2019 consumer confidence report. The report is posted around town and available on the township website.
- The 2020 monitoring schedule from the state is completed except for the remainder monthly sampling that is required. Testing of our water changes from year to year and the frequency of different samples required goes from monthly all the way to 1/108 months. We test for everything from pesticides to radiological testing.
- Monthly water meter reading for billing customers. Trouble shooting accounts that don't read properly due to damage or technical problems with meters/billing system. We run into problems almost every month we read water meters. Simple things from cut wires, damaged meter pits and more complicated issues between the census/billing software.
