Registration Policy

- **1.** All guests must stop at office upon arrival to choose a campsite or to check-in to a reserved site.
- **2.** Guests must fill out a check-in sheet with all contact information.
- **3.** Once you've completed the check-in procedure you are welcome to set-up on the campsite you have selected after our 11AM Check-In time.
- **4.** Sites will be sold starting at 9AM, but will not be vacant until 11AM.
- **5.** If you would like to extend your stay, you must let the office know by 2PM the day before you're scheduled to leave the site. (If you fail to do so, you will be asked to vacate the site; *NO EXCEPTIONS*)
- 6. Check-In /Check-Out time is 11AM
- 7. No generators!

Late Arrival Policy

- **1.** Guests arriving after hours <u>MUST</u> check the office window for a list of available sites!
- 2. Guests can setup on an available site for the night, but <u>must completely</u> fill out a late registration envelope and slip it into our drop box at the office.
- **3.** Guests with reservations can setup on their reserved site, but <u>MUST</u> check-in with the office in the morning.
- **4.** Cash & Check payments should be placed in the registration envelopes and put into the drop box. Guests who need to pay by card, can do so the following morning.

Campground Rules and Regulations

- 1. Campsite Capacity: 1 Camper/Trailer OR 1
 Camper/Trailer and 1 Tent OR 2 Tents. Maximum of six (6) people per site.
- 2. No more than two (2) vehicles and one (1) boat/ORV trailer allowed per site. Additional parking may be permitted by contacting campground office.
- 3. Vehicles or trailers shall not protrude into roadways & no parking in the roadways at any time!
- 4. Camps are to be setup within designated site boundaries only! This includes awnings, extension cords, equipment and vehicles. Any non-compliance will result in charge for a second site.
- 5. Campfires in provided fire rings only! Use ample water or sand to **COMPLETELY** extinguish your

- campfire before leaving your site. Do not burn garbage, plastic, glass, or cans in the fire pits.
- 6. Fireworks and sky lanterns are forbidden within the campground. No air guns, bows & arrows, or slingshots are allowed. Firearms must be unloaded and kept in owner's vehicle at all times.
- 7. Drones are prohibited.
- 8. A quiet time is observed at the campground between the hours of 11PM and 7AM. Noise levels should be kept at a minimum during these hours. Generators, radios, boom boxes etc. at noise levels that cannot be heard on neighboring campsites, at all times!
- 9. Speed limit is 10 MPH and will be enforced!
- 10. NO off-road vehicle (ORV) riding in the campground.
- 11. Place trash/garbage in cans situated throughout the campground. Leave your campsite clean when you depart.
- 12. Washing dishes at the water faucets on your site is prohibited. Dispose of gray water and sewage at appropriate dump stations.
- 13. All pets must be kept on a leash, at all times. Never leave your pet unattended in the park. Pickup your pet waste.
- 14. Political signs or other promotional signs are not permitted.
- 15. Subleasing of campsites is not allowed.
- 16. Please notify the office of late arrivals and cancellations. Unoccupied site with no notification will be canceled after 48 hours without refund.

Miscellaneous Information

- All electric campsites have 30 & 50-Amp service.
- TV cable can be acquired at the office. A 50' cord is available with a \$20.00 deposit.
- Showers are no charge for woodland park campers; \$3 non-camper fee
- Laundry is available in the EAST bathhouse.
- Non-Camper **Dump Fee** is \$20.00.
- If you wish to leave the park for several days, be sure your site is paid for in advance and notify the office! If your site is not paid for within 24-hours of occupancy, the site will be cleared of equipment; camping privileges will be terminated.

Woodland Park is three blocks from downtown, the marina, swimming beaches; adjacent to Pictured Rocks National Lakeshore; and only steps from Agate Beach.

Facilities include two fully equipped bath houses, laundry facilities, beach access, gray water and sewage dump station, dishwashing stations and a drinking water fill station.

Adjacent to the park is the recreational area, which includes tennis courts, basketball court, baseball/softball diamond, tot lot, and a pavilion for family picnics.


